



All non-club coaches must apply to the Selkirk Skating Club for permission to freelance coach in our sessions. Coaches MUST be in good standing with Skate Canada. Please include your name, telephone and email to this application.

Selkirk Skating Club board of directors and/or skating director will review the documentation and grant or deny permission for the current skating session only.

The freelance coach agrees to the following:

- To abide by the Coach's Code of Ethics as stated by Skate Canada
- To adhere to all the policies and rules of the Selkirk Skating Club
- To not solicit or recruit any skaters or their parents/guardians currently enrolled in any Selkirk Skating program for any program including private lessons
 - ◆ Any solicitation of Selkirk Skating Club members is strictly prohibited and will result in having their freelance privileges revoked immediately
 - ◆ Freelance coaches are not permitted to provide any coaching/lessons to any Selkirk Skating Club skaters who are at a Junior level or below on any Junior session or Open session at Selkirk Skating Club
- Any concerns must be directed to the skating director and or board of directors
- To provide a list of all their skaters they will be coaching at Selkirk Skating Club
- To ensure that all their skaters have valid Skate Canada memberships
- Selkirk Skating Club, their board, and their membership is no way held liable or responsible for any losses or damages suffered as a result of change in schedules, ice time, or cancellation of skating facility availability
- Releases the Selkirk Skating Club, management, and coaches from any action caused by damages or injuries. None of the prior shall be liable nor held responsible for accidents, injuries, damage, or loss of or to personal properties however caused.
- Freelance relationships - freelance club coaches from other skating clubs who are approved by the Selkirk Skating Club to use their facilities shall in turn extend this privilege under similar conditions as outlined in this document
 - ◆ If the freelance coach's club refuses to allow a Selkirk Skating Club coach under reasonable similar conditions set forth in this document, the Selkirk Skating Club reserves the right to terminate the freelancing coaching agreement with any club coach from that club
